

## Construction Industry Education Foundation Scholarship Application



The Construction Industry Education Foundation Inc. (Foundation) is a public charity dedicated to attracting, nurturing and mentoring those that are interested in pursuing a career in the construction industry. The Foundation is associated with the Construction Exchange of Buffalo & WNY, Inc., a regional trade association comprised of various employers engaged in the residential and commercial building industry in Western New York.

The Foundation scholarships are open to graduating high school seniors or college students who are enrolled in a full-time, construction-related certification or degree program, or those entering directly into a trade. The scholarships available through the Foundation consist of 1.) a complete set of tools for those entering a trade or 2.) a monetary scholarship for those pursuing a construction-related certification or degree program. The average amount of the monetary scholarship is \$2,000 and it can be used for tuition or related expenses such as books or computers. Scholarship funds are paid directly to the school or as a reimbursement of related expenses with a receipt. The final amount of the scholarship is determined solely by the Foundation.

Applicants will be qualified based on the following criteria:

- School attendance record
- Grades – **a complete transcript reflecting eight semesters of grades must accompany application**
- Achievements and extra-curricular activities
- Personal interview
